Nursing Personnel manage patients receiving sedative or analgesic medications undergoing invasive diagnostic or therapeutic procedures. Joint commission standards, ASA classifications, AANA and ASA guidelines for medication administration, patient monitoring, discharge instruction, family teaching and patient safety concerns are critical care elements reviewed.

- Administer moderate sedation safely.
- Effectively manage complications which might arise during moderate sedation
